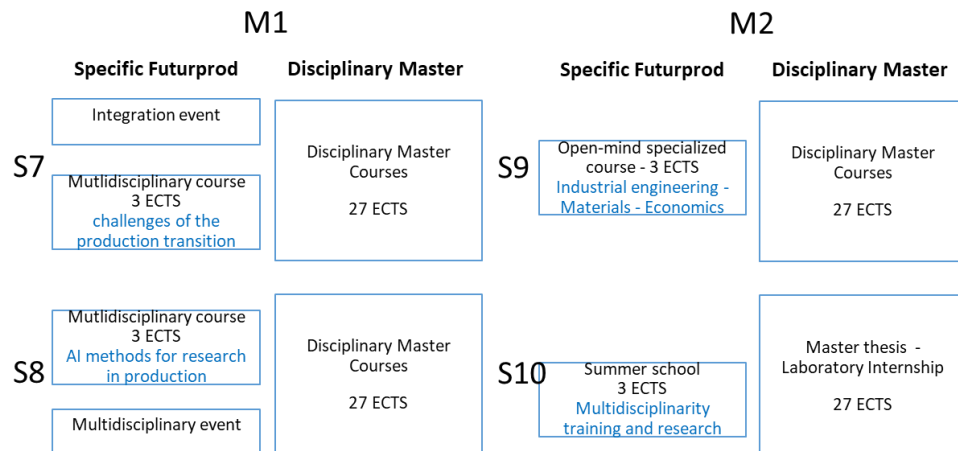
for research that contributes to the transition of sustainable industrial production systems in an open-minded multidisciplinary environment
